By Order adopted July 11, 2007, at the above-referenced docket numbers, the Commission approved the applications of DCT Telecom Group, Inc. 

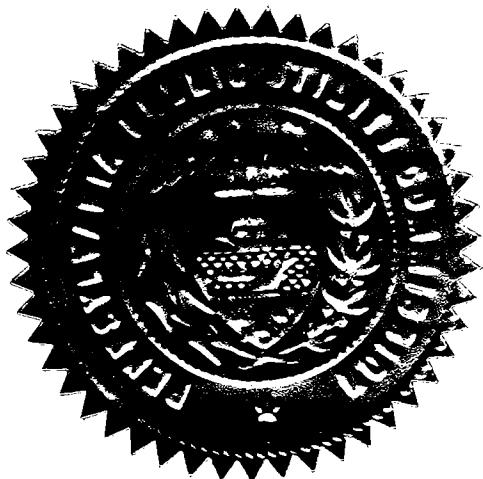

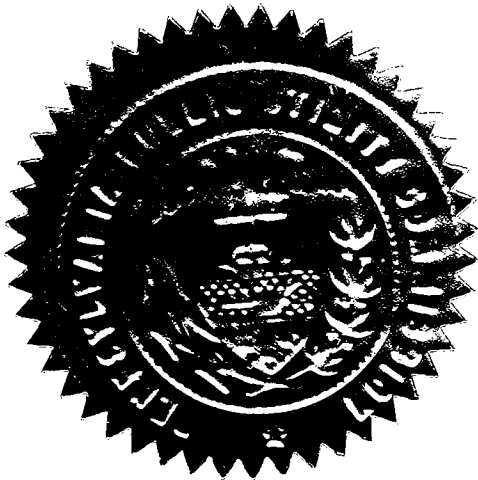
